I would like to take the opportunity to thank the parents from Nursery and Reception who were able to attend the Parent Partnership Focus Groups this week. Reception have been busy learning all about Kings and Queens as part of their topic for this half term. Thank you for all your kind donations for our junk modelling area. The children have enjoyed creating lots of different models and have been thinking carefully about what materials they needed to create their designs. In our outdoor area this week we have been practising our gross motor skills by taking part in team games such as tenpin bowling and kicking balls at a target net. Next week we will be making a throne for our castle role play and taking it in turns to be a King or a Queen for the day! Year 1 have been learning to write persuasive letters to persuade Mummy's to let them stay up late! They have read the story books all about Pigeon and what he wants to do and how he tries to persuade others to let him do it! In maths we have learnt to recognise British coins and understand their value. The children were very enthused to learn all about Scotland this week in Geography as they know all the countries which make up the United Kingdom. They learnt about the great mystery of Lake Loch Ness and is there or isn't there a creature which roams in the deep?



Year 2 have been busy continuing their learning in Maths this week, focusing on telling the time. This week we have been focusing on 5 minute intervals, sequencing events and durations of time. In Geography this week, we

have been learning about human and physical features. We used Google Earth to travel to some exciting places and decide whether they were a human or physical feature!
