Dear Parents & Carers

Due to the short notice there will be some changes within Class 2B and we will inform parents of Class 2B early next week of these changes. Your child's education is always our first priority.

This week Nursery have been looking at dinosaurs and fossils. They have really enjoyed watching videos on how fossils are formed and where we might find them. The caterpillars we have in nursery have doubled in size and the children are really excited for the next part of their lifecycle.

Reception have been very busy this week learning all about the King's Coronation. We have been role-playing using our class 'throne' and we even made our own crowns. Outdoors, we have been looking out for signs of spring and did some observational drawings of our findings. Please remember to send Reception children to school in their PE kits every Monday for our PE sessions. This half term in PE, we have been learning how to use our bodies to balance beanbags and hoops.

This week, Year 2 have been learning all about Greta Thunberg. We will be innovating our biographies about David Attenborough and replacing the information with our new research about Greta. In Maths, we have been learning about volume and have had fun using the containers and water to do so!

In English, Year 1 have been innovating persuasive letters and writing from the perspective of objects, for example the pencils which have been chewed or the glue sticks with no lids. In maths we have been learning to understand volume and capacity. In geography we have learnt to locate Wales on a map of the UK. Discuss the location of the capital city, Cardiff. Explain that Cardiff is on the coast (where the land meets the sea) and it is located on quite flat land. We looked at a relief map of Wales that shows the shape of the land, so we can see where hills and mountains are located. In history this week we have been learning the story that when King John I died, his son became king, and that like his father, King Henry III also upset the barons. In science this week we have been learning how plants make seeds to reproduce. They then need the seeds to spread out and land somewhere suitable for the seeds to germinate.

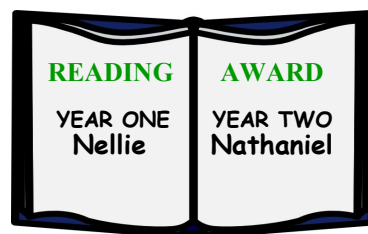
